# President's Message, Patricia Staebler, SRA



#### Dear Colleagues,


In 25 years living in Florida, I have been through my share of hurricanes, and I have seen it all, from the pre-disaster valuation to the post-disaster adjusting. But I have never seen anything like the catastrophe Hurricane Ian left behind. Unimaginable damage, incredible flooding miles and miles away from the coast in areas which are not in flood plains. Only 20% of residents who experienced flood damage carry flood insurance. As an appraiser in the insurance industry, I encourage all of you to purchase flood insurance, regardless which flood zone your property is located in.

Flooding in Wauchula, Arcadia and Myakka City can be explained with all the rivers flowing in the middle of the state, but look at Kissimmee, which is close to lakes, but not to rivers. Heavy flooding occurred in this ar-

ea. My neighbor, an avid fisherman, was fishing in these lakes a couple days before the storm and he reported that he could feel the drift of the water flowing south. The authorities prepared for the storm by releasing water into Lake Okeechobee. Florida's disadvantage is its flatness and the connection of the river and lake systems over long inland stretches. <u>We all live</u> <u>in a flood zone</u> and the public needs to realize that. FEMA might be fast in disaster response, but it will take decades for them to adjust flood maps to go along with reality and future climate changes which will make it even worse.

Our hearts go out to all who have lost lives, homes, and businesses. I truly hope that all of you are in good health. For those who were lucky enough to get away unharmed, I encourage you to donate to the



<u>Appraisal Institute Relief Foundation</u> and of course other organizations assisting Floridians in the disaster areas.

I hope we will have a happy reunion at the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Chapter Meeting in Naples when I hand over the gavel to our future chapter president Tim Sunyog. I am so much looking forward to seeing you all.

Progress requirements and accomplishments may be reviewed under the Candidate's **My Account** tab of the Appraisal Institute website within the **Candidate Status Report** and **Candidate Minimum Progress** table.

You may have heard, the National Board approved changes to the Annual Minimum Progress requirement. Going forward, while Candidates are recommended to complete sufficient requirements per year to fulfill their timeline, they will be considered to have met Annual Minimum Progress if they have completed – or attempted to complete – at least one requirement per year.
